# FULL INCLUSION MODEL IMPLEMENTED

European Aquatics is proud to introduce  
a Full Inclusion Model for athletes with disabilities.

Under this model:

- Athletes with disabilities will compete fully integrated within the main programme
- Athletes will be included in start lists based on official entry times
- Equal competition conditions will be ensured for all athletes

All venues and services have been prepared to support accessibility, including:

- Accessible accommodation
- Barrier-free athlete access routes
- Accessible athlete preparation areas
- Integrated medical and athlete services

This initiative represents a historic step toward fully inclusive Masters aquatics.





# PARTICIPATION CRITERIA

## PARA AQUATICS

The present criteria establish the participation conditions applicable to Para Swimming and Para Open Water Swimming athletes wishing to compete at the European Aquatics Masters Championships 2026.

## PARTICIPATION

The Para Swimming and Para Open Water Swimming programme is designed to promote participation while maintaining appropriate competition standards.

Participation is open to athletes entered by:

- National Federations
- Recognised disability sport organisations

European Aquatics will accept entries from organisations not affiliated with European Aquatics, provided they are formally affiliated with or recognised within the International Paralympic Committee (IPC) structure.

## REGISTRATION

Para athletes must follow the standard registration process applicable to all Masters participants.

All entries must be submitted through the official event website: [www.eamasters26.com](http://www.eamasters26.com)

Final entry deadline: **15 July 2026**

Entries submitted outside the official platform will not be considered valid.

## ENTRY TIMES

To enter a Para Swimming event, athletes are not required to achieve a qualifying time.

However, all athletes must submit an official valid entry time:

- Achieved in official competitions
- Between **15 July 2024 and 15 July 2026**
- Supported by verifiable competition results

European Aquatics reserves the right to request evidence confirming the validity of entry times.



## CLASSIFICATION

Athletes must meet the applicable classification requirements.

### Sport Classes S1–S14

Athletes must hold a recognised sport class within the World Para Swimming classification system.

- National classification will be accepted for entry
- Classification documentation must be provided, including classification sheets and relevant medical documentation
- European Aquatics classifiers may review and request additional information

### Sport Classes S15, S16, S21

Athletes must submit a signed medical report describing the athlete's disability.

Final validation of classification remains under the authority of the event classification panel.

## SPORT CLASSES

The Para Swimming and Para Open Water Swimming events will include athletes in the following sport classes:

- S1–S14 (physical, visual and intellectual impairments recognised under the World Para Swimming framework)
- S15 (deaf)
- S16 (autism)
- S21 (down syndrome)

## COMPETITION FORMAT AND RESULTS

Competition results will be determined by age groups using a points-based system in order to allow comparison between swimmers from different sport classes.

The following scoring systems will apply:

- World Para Swimming (WPS) Points System for sport classes S1–S14
- World Aquatics Points System for sport classes S15, S16 and S21

## GENERAL PROVISIONS

European Aquatics reserves the right to request supporting documentation and to clarify or adjust operational procedures where necessary to ensure the smooth organisation of the competition.

# PARA WATER POLO COMPETITION INFORMATION

Para Water Polo will be included in the European Aquatics Masters Championships 2026 as part of the Full Inclusion Model, providing athletes with the opportunity to participate within the Championships framework.

The Para Water Polo programme is currently under development, with classification procedures and competition format to be finalised.

## PROVISIONAL SCHEDULE

Classification Days:

**24–25 August 2026 (to be confirmed)**

Competition Days:

**26–27 August 2026 (to be confirmed)**

## PARTICIPATION

Participation will be open to teams entered by:

- National Federations
- Recognised organisations within the Paralympic sport structure

All athletes will be required to meet applicable classification requirements. Documentation and procedures will be communicated in due course.

# WATER POLO RULES

## Exceptions for Para Water Polo

Considering that Para Water Polo will be played by people with different levels of ability, some adaptations are necessary to ensure athlete safety while maintaining a fair competitive environment for all. As such, a classification system will be implemented to evaluate the competitive ability of each player, and the Water Polo Rules will be adapted as follows:

(With reference to the Rules in force as from February 2026)

- **Rule 2.2.2 Subject to Appendix 7 of this Part Six each team's Start List must include a minimum of seven (7) and a maximum of fourteen (14) Players who may participate in that match. Each Start List must include:**

**Exception:** Each team's Start List must include a minimum of seven (7) and a maximum of fifteen (15) players who may participate in that match. All players must be eligible under the classification rules.

- **Rule 2.2.2.1 a maximum of twelve (12) Players must be designated as Field Players.**

**Exception:** A maximum of thirteen (13) players must be designated as Field Players.

- **Rule 2.3.1 Each team must start the match with seven (7) Players on the Field of Play, one (1) of which must be a Goalkeeper**

**Exception:** Additionally the sum of all classification points for players participating in the game for each team at any given moment must not exceed 20 points.

If at any point during the game the number of players in the Field of Play for one team is reduced, due to insufficient number of eligible players or to exclusion for Violent Action, the maximum number of classification points for that team will be reduced by 2,5 points for each absent player.

For mixed gender games, a credit in the number of classification points will be attributed to female players.

- **Rule 2.2.3.2 a maximum of two (2) members of medical staff.**

**Exception:** One member of medical staff can be replaced, at the team's discretion, by one personal assistant to help players enter and exit the water. No formal qualifications shall be required for this role, and this support can equally be provided by any other member of staff.



- **Rule 2.3.8 Substitutes and any Player not on the Field of Play must be positioned:**

**Exception:** Substitute players may remain in the flying substitution area, near their team bench, outside the Field of Play and not interfering with it or with the game in any way.

- **Rule 2.4.4 Team medical staff must be seated on the team bench, except when required to attend to a Player or other medical needs.**

**Exception:** Team medical staff, personal assistant or any other staff member can assist a player that requires help entering or exiting the pool, provided that they do not interfere with the game or the Field of Play.

- **Rule 2.5.3.2.2 enter the Field of Play from their team's Flying Substitution Area, only after both Players have touched hands above the water.**

**Exception:** Touching any part of the body clearly visible above the water is also admissible.

- **Rule 3.11.1 Two (2) Secretaries will be located at the Officials' Table**

**Exception:** Three (3) Secretaries will be located at the Officials' Table, one of which will record all substitutions and respective changes in the total number of Classification Points.

- **Rule 3.11.2 The Secretaries will:**

- **Rule 3.11.2.4 Signal with a red flag, or by another approved method of signaling, for:**

**Exception:** 3.11.2.4.3 any Improper Entry of a Substitute causing a team to exceed the maximum number of Classification Points.

- **Rule 4.1 Each match will have four Periods, each of eight (8) minutes of Actual Play.**

**Exception:** Each Period consists of seven (7) minutes of Actual Play.

- **Rule 4.3 There will be an interval between each Period of:**

**Exception:** Five (5) minutes.

- **Rule 5.2 The duration of a Timeout is (1) minute.**

**Exception:** The duration of a Timeout is 90 seconds.

- **Rule 5.6 In accordance with Article 3.10 of this Part Six, the Timekeepers will by whistle or other audible method announce:**

- **Rule 5.6.1 once forty-five (45) seconds of a Timeout has passed, at which point the Players of both teams are permitted to move anywhere in the Field of Play; and**

**Exception:** The Timekeepers will signal fifteen (15) seconds before the end of the Timeout.

- **Rule 8.2.11.2 touches (intentionally or otherwise) the ball with two (2) hands at the same time, unless by the Goalkeeper while within the 6 Meter Area; or**

**Exception:** Touching the ball with two (2) hands at the same time is permitted for passing



or shooting, but not to control the ball, protect it from defending players, block shots and passes or any other actions.

- **Rule 9.1 A team may retain Possession without shooting at the opponent's Goal for no more than 28 seconds of Actual Play.**

**Exception:** A team may retain Possession without shooting at the opponent's Goal for no more than 45 seconds of Actual Play.

- **Rule 9.8.2.2 if the team that shot the ball regains Possession, that team is then able to maintain Possession without shooting at the opponent's Goal for a maximum of 18 seconds of Actual Play.**

**Exception:** If the team that shot the ball regains Possession, that team is then able to maintain Possession without shooting at the opponent's Goal for a maximum of 30 seconds of Actual Play.

All other times specified in the rules shall be adjusted accordingly.

- **Rule 11.1.6 A Player, including any excluded Player or Substitute, commits Improper Entry:**

**Exception:** 11.1.6.4 If at any point during the game the maximum number of Classification Points is exceeded by a team, in which case a Penalty Throw is awarded to the opposing team, but no Personal Foul is registered to the offending player.

- **Rule 20.2.2.1 Length: the distance between the inner edge of the two (2) Goal Lines must be 25.00 meters.**

**Exception:** The distance between the inner edge of the two (2) Goal Lines must be no less than 20.00 and no more than 25.00 meters.

- **Rule 20.2.2.2 Width: the distance between the inner edge of the two (2) Side Lines must be 20.00 meters.**

**Exception:** The distance between the inner edge of the two (2) Side Lines must be no less than 15.00 and no more than 20.00 meters.

- **Rule 21.2.4 in men's matches, have:**
- **Rule 21.2.4.1 a circumference of between 0.68 metres and 0.71 metres; and**
- **Rule 21.2.4.2 an air pressure of between 7.5 and 8.5 pounds per square inch atmospheric; and**
- **Rule 21.2.5 in women's matches, must have:**
- **Rule 21.2.5.1 a circumference of between 0.65 metres and 0.67 metres; and**
- **Rule 21.2.5.2 an air pressure of between 6.5 and 7.5 pounds per square inch atmospheric.**

**Exception:** For all matches the ball must have:

- a circumference of between 0.65 meters and 0.67 meters; and
- an air pressure of between 6.5 and 7.5 pounds per square inch atmospheric.

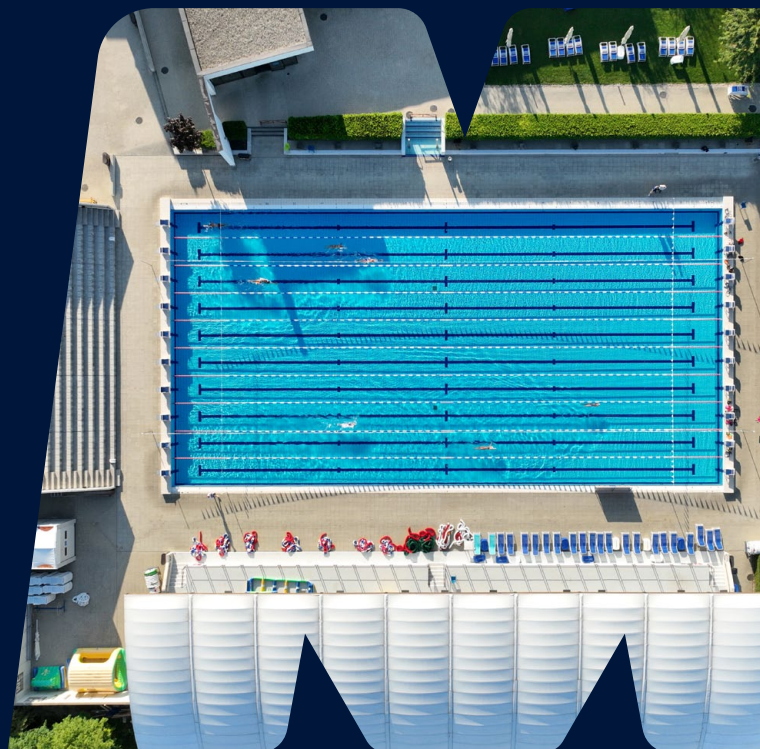

## SWIMMING AND WATER POLO COMPETITION FACILITIES

The x-bionic® sphere aquatic complex provides Olympic-standard competition facilities.

# CONNECTIVITY AND TRANSPORT

## OFFICIAL TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM

An official Championships transportation system will be provided to support athlete and team mobility during the event.

Transportation services will operate between:

- Official Championships accommodation locations, including x-bionic® sphere and partner hotels
- Competition venues in Šamorín and Bratislava
- Official Championships hotels and key operational locations

This system will ensure reliable and convenient transport for athletes, teams, and accredited participants, supporting smooth access to training sessions, competitions, and Championships services.

## INTERNATIONAL ACCESS

The Championships are easily accessible via major international airports:

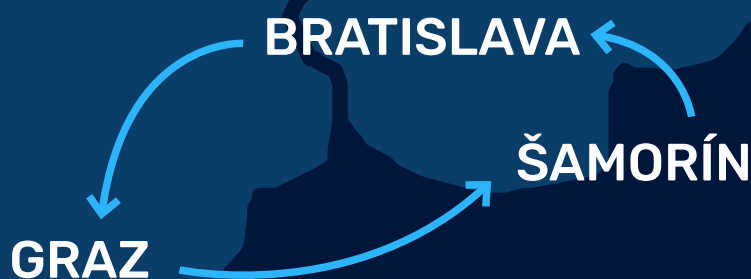
- Vienna International Airport (Austria) – approximately 45 minutes from Šamorín

- Graz Airport (Austria) – located within the host city
