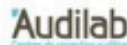

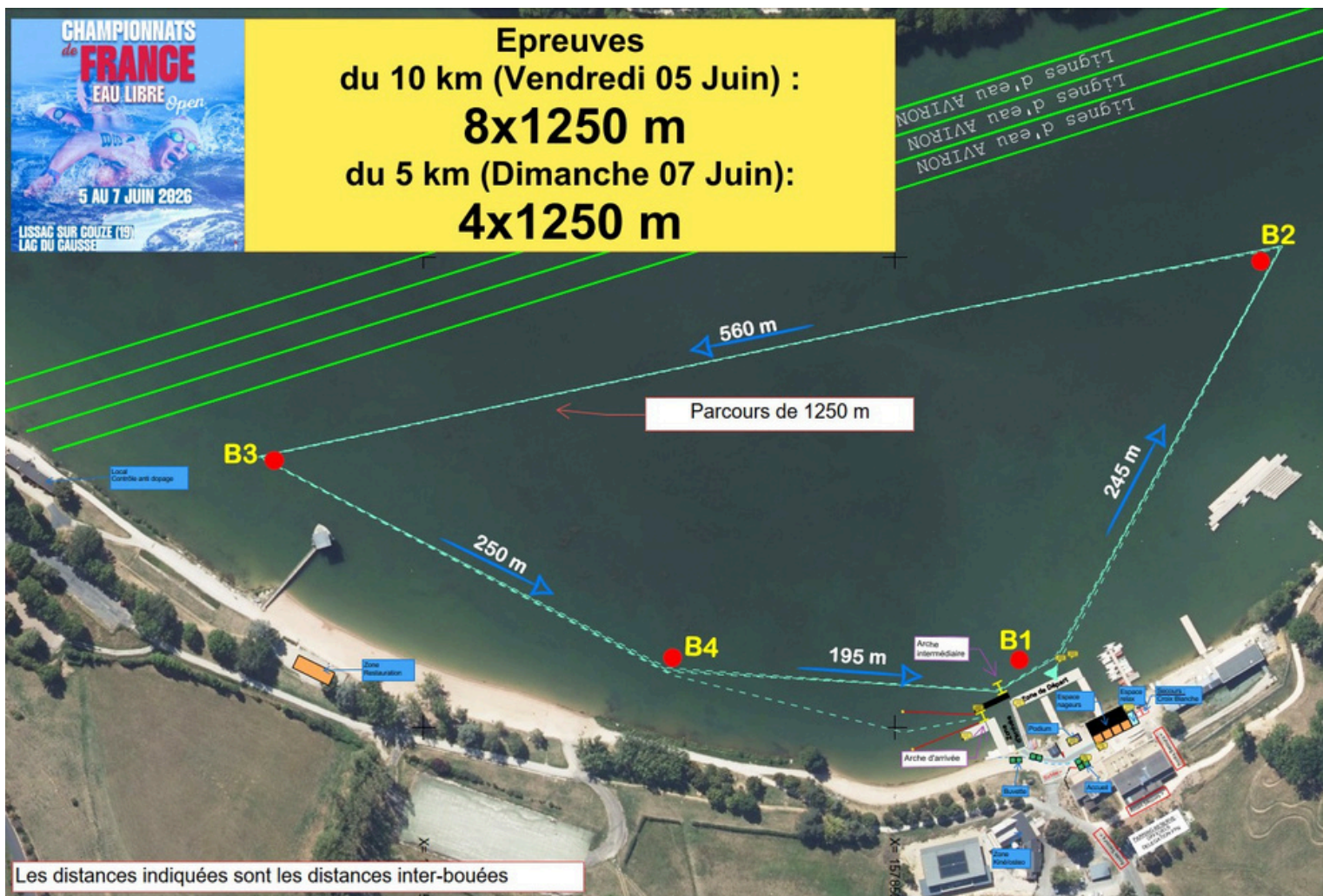

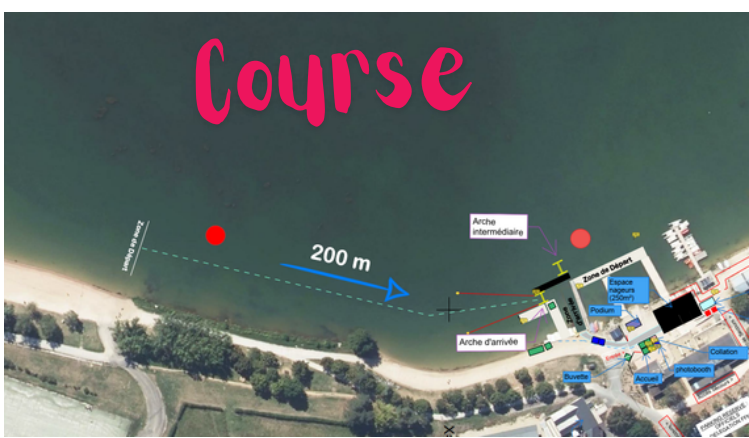

REGULATIONS



IMAGE RIGHTS :

By registering, competitors authorize the organizers and their assignees, such as partners and media, to use still or audiovisual images in which they may appear, taken during their participation in the event, on any medium including for possible screenings.

In accordance with the French Data Protection Act of 6 January 1978, participants have the right to access and rectify their personal data. If they do not wish to receive offers from other companies or associations, they must inform the organizer in writing, indicating their full name and address.

COMMITMENT AND RESPONSIBILITY :

Furthermore, registration for the event constitutes a waiver of liability by which the registered swimmer acknowledges, in particular:

- having read the "REGULATIONS" of the event which he undertakes to comply with,
- being sufficiently trained to cover the distance for which he has registered,
- that in full knowledge of the facts on the day of the event, he will be under his sole responsibility to decide whether he feels capable of starting the event for which he has registered, both from the point of view of his physical and mental means at the time, and from the point of view of the weather conditions which he feels capable of facing,
- that in all cases, both for himself and for his beneficiaries, he releases the organizers from all liability for any reason whatsoever, to take it upon himself to arrange for any insurance and any possible recourse against any participant or third party responsible for any damage whatsoever to him.

Civil liability : In accordance with current legislation, the organizer has taken out insurance covering the financial consequences of its civil liability, that of its employees and all participants.

Regarding the civil liability of participants, this insurance coverage is limited to accidents they may cause during the sporting event. Furthermore, this coverage will supplement, or replace, any other insurance they may already have.

Those without a license are required to present the organizer with a medical certificate less than 1 year old attesting to the absence of any contraindication to the practice of swimming or triathlon in competition. , A French Open Water Swimming Federation license will be automatically subscribed for those not licensed with the FFN.

Property damage : The organizer accepts no responsibility for any damage (theft, breakage, loss, etc.) to participants' personal belongings, even if they are in the organizer's custody. Participants may not hold the organizer liable for any damage to their equipment.

Taking out insurance to cover these risks is the responsibility of each individual.

Safety : it will be ensured on the water by SNSM and on land by the White Cross and a doctor.

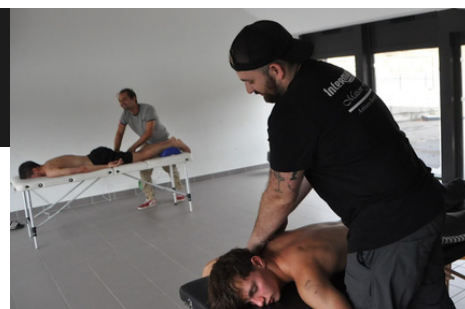

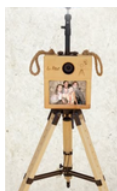

Cyanobactéries dans l'eau : quelles mesures de précaution ?

Les Cyanobactéries : qu'est-ce que c'est ?

En période estivale, certaines conditions (teneurs élevées en phosphore – écoulements lents – ensoleillement – apports en azote et en phosphore...) peuvent être à l'origine, sur les rivières et plans d'eau, de prolifération de micro-organismes cyanobactéries en raison de leur couleur généralement bleue.

Certaines cyanobactéries libèrent, en fin de saison chaude (fin de leur cycle de vie), des toxines qui peuvent être à l'origine de troubles pour la santé humaine (diarrhées – troubles digestifs – céphalées – réactions dermatologiques – atteinte du système nerveux et du foie) plus ou moins intenses selon leurs concentrations dans l'eau.

Les animaux sont aussi vulnérables à ces toxines qui peuvent s'avérer mortelles pour eux (petits organismes et ingestion de grande quantité d'eau). A l'inverse, aucun cas mortel humain lié aux cyanobactéries n'a été recensé en France.

Quelles précautions à prendre en présence de cyanobactéries ?

Lorsque ces micro-algues (aspect visqueux dans l'eau) se développent dans l'eau, il est conseillé de limiter les expositions: la baignade, le contact avec l'eau, l'ingestion d'eau ou encore la consommation des poissons sont à éviter à la fois pour les humains et les animaux domestiques.

Une vigilance visuelle des responsables des sites mais aussi des usagers, permet un premier niveau de précaution, mais des analyses de l'eau de sites faisant l'objet d'une surveillance de l'ARS, permettent de quantifier les cellules de cyanobactéries présentes dans l'eau. En Nouvelle-Aquitaine, à partir d'un seuil de 20 000 cellules de cyanobactéries par millilitre, la surveillance de l'eau est renforcée et une information de vigilance est affichée sur les sites de baignade ; à compter de 100 000 cellules de cyanobactéries par millilitre d'eau, la baignade est interdite par mesure de sécurité.
